A weekend of great results for FLCC.

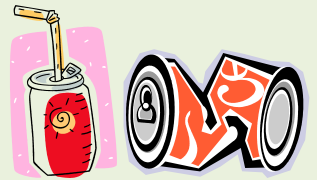
