The Steersperson is always in charge of the boat.

Dock Safety

- PFDs are compulsory on the Club Docks.
- Minimize number of paddlers waiting on the dock fingers.
- Load promptly, as directed by the steersperson.
- Always untie a boat before loading –

1st Aid

- Hypothermia is a serious condition.
- Watch Cold Water Bootcamp.
- Call 911 for emergencies.
- Ambulance address – North end of Church St, Fort Langley.
- Consider using alternate shore for Ambulance access.
